Philosophy

Enrollment

Enrollment is open for children 2 years by September of the school year, through age 5. Children do not need to be toiled trained to attend. Hope Lutheran Preschool admits students of any race, creed, color and ethnic origin to all programs and activities. Hope also has an excellent Day School for children Kindergarten through 8th Grade.

Mission Statement

Our Staff

Our teaching staff consists of Christian instructors who are well qualified and experienced in early childhood development. They are dedicated to the growth and development of your children and provide a loving and caring environment. Our low teacher to child ratio allows us to give your child individual attention. Preschool teachers are state qualified and are continually upgrading their skills through workshops and special classes.

Curriculum

The curriculum is based on developmentally appropriate activities geared for young children. Curriculum is planned for the development of the "whole child" in many different areas which include: creative art, math and reading readiness, science, social studies, language arts, Bible stories, music and rhythm, physical development through large and small muscles activities, dramatic play, cooking and field trips.

Discipline

Children are:

- Praised for acceptable behavior
- Redirected to acceptable activities
- Taught acceptable behavior
- Carefully supervised to anticipate problems before they occur
- Given a short time out on a chair or bench when the child's behavior is harmful to another child, to themselves or willfully disobedient.



Rest Time

"All children must be given the opportunity to rest free of distraction" (State licensing code). Children will have a "quiet time" after lunch. They may either sleep or rest. After resting a variety of activities are planned.



Goals

We believe that children are created by God and designed to grow to their fullest potential - spiritually, socially, emotionally, physically and cognitively.

- Spiritually - - To know Jesus and his Love.
- Socially- - To encourage each child to think and act for themselves and to live in harmony with others.
- Emotionally- - To help the child develop a good self-concept by accepting the child as God made them with warmth, love and praise.
- Physically- -To grow and develop small and large muscles through physical activities.
- Cognitively- -To provide challenges at the child's level without pressure or fear of failure

Nutrition

A morning and afternoon snack is provided each day. Each snack includes two food groups. A Hot Lunch program is available at an additional fee.
